例) Nancy is a student, isn't she ? (ナンシ - は学生ですよ。)

例) Takeo bought a book at that store , didn't he ?

例) You aren't a student, are you ?

* 「～ですね」と念を押したり,同意を求めたりする表現

* 前の文が肯定文 否定の疑問文,前の文が否定文 肯定の疑問文

* つけ加える部分の主語は,代名詞にする

* 命令文の付加疑問文は will you?, Let's ~ の付加疑問文は shall we?

例) Open the window, will you?(窓を開けてくださいね。)

Don't open the window, will you?(窓を開けないでね。)

Let's open the window, shall we?(窓を開けましょうね。)
